

FIX I/V was created by three nurses with over 25 years of experience working in paediatric hospitals. They identified significant problems with holding IVs in place for infants and children. Every day, and sometimes several times a day, children had to have their IV catheters reinserted which at times caused serious consequences such as infections and traumas.

Their expertise in the field allowed them to design and create a new splint concept to solve this problem.
